#### **Dates:**

#### **Location:**

Sikorsky Aircraft, Stratford, CT

#### **Eligibility:**

Each troop may register **four** youth members, two adults, and two alternate youth members. Youth Members must be at least 14 years old and Scouts must First Class or above. Camp Sikorsky is limited to 500 participants. At least one leader must attend from every unit. If female Venturers are attending, a female leader must attend. Every effort will be made to accommodate those with disabilities and/or medical conditions.

#### **Cost:**

\$40.00 (for Scouts and adults), if paid by July 31, includes Merit Badge instruction, meals (Friday snack, all meals on Saturday, and Sunday breakfast), and Camp Sikorsky patch. The fee is \$50.00 after July 31 and for out-of-Council participants.

#### **Registration Process:**

Completed Registration Form and fees must be submitted by 5:00 p.m. on July 31, 2006, to the Scout Resource Center. Fees must be submitted with your registration form. Registrations will not be processed without proper forms and payment. Space is limited. Those registered without a rank, social security number, or citizenship will not be considered. Proper registration forms must be used.
